

Mr. St. Pierre's classes cell Phone Policy (revised 08/29/16)

Objective: SWBAT to distinguish and become disciplined in understanding the difference between time in school (a professional setting) when cell phone use is appropriate (and what is appropriate use) and when it is not.

- During “academic learning time” (aka your A, B, C, and D blocks/ the time when you are supposed to be in class learning!) your phone should be turned off and put away.
- During academic transitional time (time during the school day that is in between classes, **academic support**, homeroom, and **hallways**) your phone is allowed to be turned on for **communicative purposes only**)

Communicative purposes: talking/texting with your parents/guardians, this does not include time on apps such as FB, Snapchat, Instagram, etc.

- No games whatsoever are allowed to be played during the school day. (**YOU ARE IN SCHOOL TO LEARN NOT PLAY VIDEO GAMES!**)
- Mr. St. Pierre will **lead by example** and will not use his cell phone in the presence of students during academic learning time.

Consequences for breaking cell phone policy.

- If student is using their cell phone device during academic learning time it will be taken away and returned at the end of the school day
- If a student is using their cell phone device inappropriately *during transitions* (i.e. playing a game) they will be warned once and asked politely to put it away, and upon second request will have the phone confiscated for the day.
