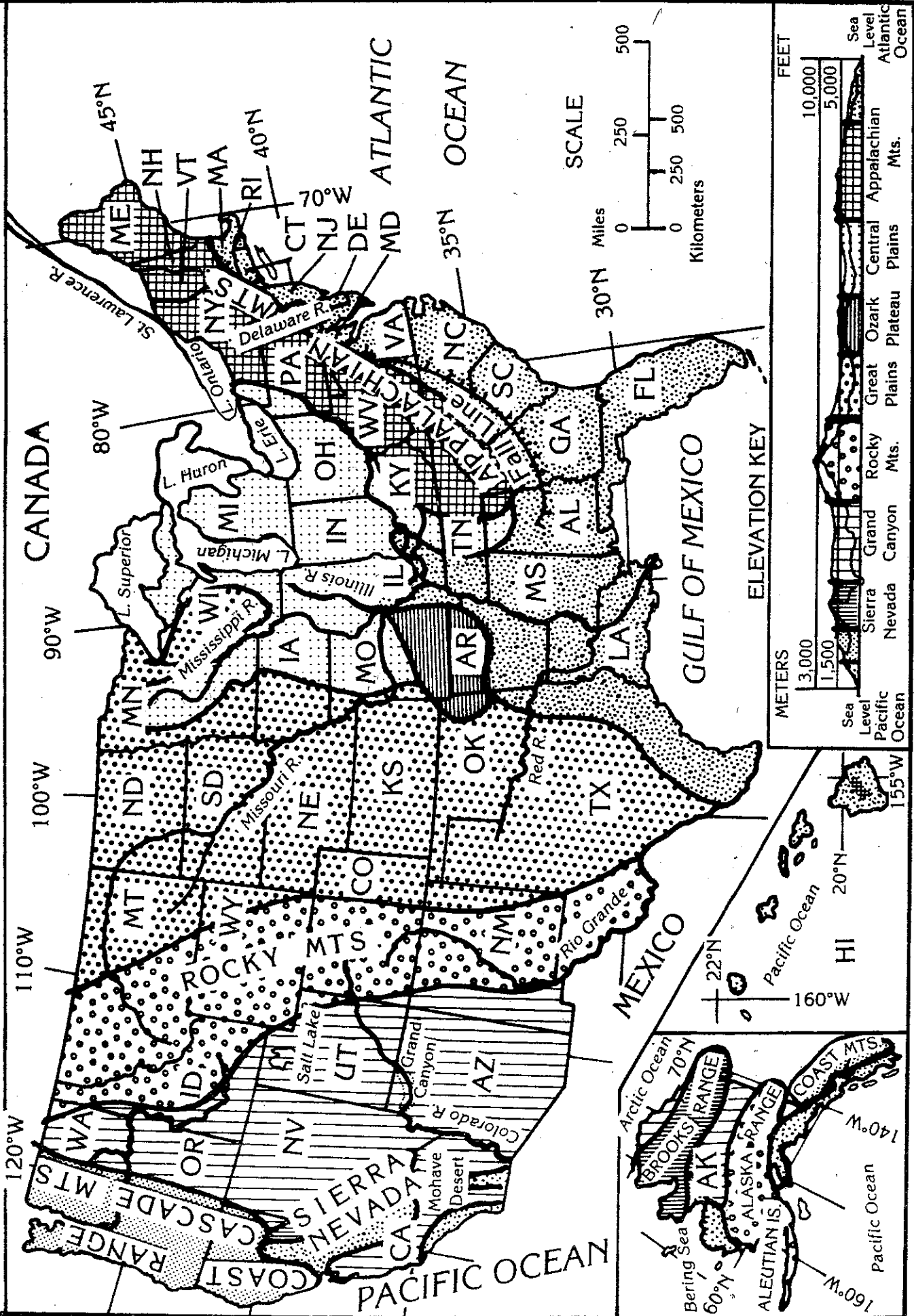


PHYSICAL MAP USA

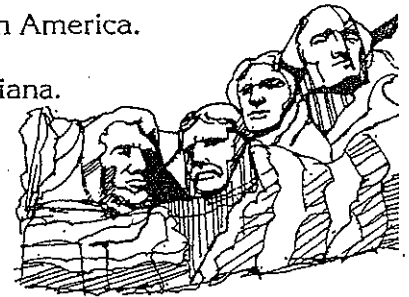
